BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT,
STATE OF ARKANSAS AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE REMOVING FUND RESTRICTION AND ESTABLISHING
NEW FUND OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT AS REQUIRED BY STATE
LAW.

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Department of Legislative Audit has determined that it
is necessary in accordance with state law that the Grant County Quorum Court approve
by ordinance the modification and establishment of funds for the county of Grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF
GRANT COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the following general fund that was established with ordinance
number 2009-04 and renumber with ordinance 2011-08 be modified in accordance with
state law for the specific purposes set forth hereto:

County General Reserve Fund - 1001

This Fund was established for the purpose of setting aside monies for
building and/or remodeling projects. It is the desire of the Court that the
restrictions on the Fund be removed and the monies be set aside for
utilization as the need arises. Disbursement (distribution) of monies in
said Fund shall be at the discretion of the Grant County Quorum Court.

SECTION 2: That the following road fund be authorized in accordance with state
law for the specific purposes set forth hereto:

County Road Reserve Fund - 2001

Established for the purpose of setting aside monies in a reserve fund for
utilization as the need arises. Disbursement (distribution) of monies in
said Fund shall be at the discretion of the Grant County Quorum Court.

SECTION 3: That any conflicting part(s) of previous Ordinances, Resolutions or
County Court Orders with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the degree of conflict;
the remaining and/or additional material of said previous Ordinances, Resolutions or
County Court Orders shall remain unaffected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: Severability. If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, such
invalidity shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: In order to promote the public peace, safety and welfare of the
citizens of Grant County, Arkansas, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance
shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval.
