**“AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL
APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2018-06, THE 2019 ANNUAL
BUDGET, GRANT COUNTY ARKANSAS.”**

WHEREAS, it has been determined there is a need to establish a reserve for future purchases of communication equipment, and

WHEREAS, this Court desires the money for said purchases be set aside in a restricted fund for the sole purpose of purchasing communication equipment.

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Quorum Court of Grant County, Arkansas that a fund be established so titled “Communication Equipment 2017 Tax Reserve Fund” and given fund number 3408. This Fund is established for the sole purpose of purchasing communication equipment utilized by First Responders and Grant County 911. This Fund is utilizing money received from the Emergency Medical Service 2017 Tax and is to comply with the purchase restrictions of said taxes.

WHEREAS, this Court desires that money be transferred into the newly established fund for the calendar year 2019.

THEREFORE, this Court amends the 2019 budget for said purpose.

Section 1. Budget Amendment.

This amendment to the 2019 Annual Budget, Grant County Arkansas appropriates a transfer of \$50,000.00 from the Emergency Medical Service 2017 Tax Fund to the Communication Equipment 2017 Tax Reserve Fund.

Section 2. Purpose. This Ordinance shall constitute new appropriations for the purposes specified for the calendar year 2019 subject only to revision or modification by the Quorum Court.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of the Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provision or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance being necessary for the protection and preservation of public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in force and shall take effect upon passage and approval.
