Be It Enacted By the Quorum Court of Grant County, State of Arkansas:

An Ordinance to be Entitled: "An Ordinance to Name the County Collector the Preparer of the Tax Books; and to Repeal Ordinance No. 1990-7.

Article 1. Affirmation. It comes before this Court that there is a need to change the Preparer of the Tax Books in order to streamline the process. This Court recognizes and affirms said need.

Article 2. Designation. In accordance with the authorization provided in Arkansas Code § 26-28-102 this Court designates the County Collector as the official preparer of the tax books. The County Collector shall follow all state laws regarding preparation of the tax books. The County Clerk, Assessor, Collector and Treasurer shall each cooperate in the accumulation, exchange, transmission, certification and storage of data contained in their respective offices which may be used or requested by the preparer of the tax books.

Article 3. Repealer. Grant County Ordinance No. 1990-7, which primarily named the County Assessor as the preparer of the tax books is hereby repealed.
