BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

“AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AN ELECTRONIC WARRANTS TRANSFER (DIRECT DEPOSIT) SYSTEM DIRECTLY INTO PAYEES’ ACCOUNTS IN FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS IN PAYMENT OF ANY ACCOUNT ALLOWED AGAINST THE COUNTY.”

Section 1. The Grant County Quorum Court, as authorized by State Statute §14-24-121, does hereby authorize Grant County to establish an electronic warrants transfer (direct deposit) system directly into payees’ accounts in financial institutions in payment of any account allowed against the County. The electronic payment method to be established shall provide for the appropriate internal accounting controls and documentation for audit and accounting purposes.

Section 2. The electronic warrants transfer system established under Section 1 shall comply with the information systems best practices approved by the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee.

Section 3. If any provision of the Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4. In order to promote the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Grant County, Arkansas, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval.
