BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2020-11, THE 2021 ANNUAL BUDGET, GRANT COUNTY ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Grant County Sheriff Department has provided department issued cell phones for the officers to utilize for official communication which are paid for from the Sheriff's Communication Fund; and

WHEREAS, it has become more efficient for the officers to utilize their personal cell phones to handle the situations where a cell phone is the best communication method; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court desires there to be a pay allowance of \$20.00 added to each officers bi-weekly pay to help offset the cost of their personal cell phone; and

WHEREAS, this expense shall be reimbursed to the County General Fund from the Sheriff's Communication Fund on a monthly basis; and

WHEREAS, a policy has been established by the Sheriff that addresses the requirements for the accessibility and use of a personal cell phone in regards to official department communication.

THEREFORE, this Court amends the 2021 budget for said purpose.

**Section 1. Budget Amendment.**

This amendment to the 2021 Annual Budget, Grant County Arkansas increases the appropriation for expenditures for the Sheriff Department (400) from the County General Fund (1000) by the following.

Other Fringe Benefits 1000-0400-1012 \$5,120.00

**Section 2. Purpose.** This Ordinance shall constitute new appropriations for the purposes specified for the calendar year 2021 subject only to revision or modification by the Quorum Court.

**Section 3. Revenue.** This Ordinance shall reflect unanticipated revenue of \$5,120.00 for the County General Fund in the 2021 Annual Budget, Grant County Arkansas.

**Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of the Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provision or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in force and shall take effect upon passage and approval.
