AN ORDINANCE FOR PERMITTING THE COUNTY TO PURCHASE SERVICES BHOCK OCCUMENTATION OF THE COUNTY OCCUMENTATION OCCUMENTA

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code 14-14-1202 (2)(A)(i) states that if the quorum court determines that it is in the best interest of the county, the quorum court may by ordinance permit the county to purchase goods or services directly or indirectly from quorum court members, county officers, or county employees due to unusual circumstances; and

WHEREAS, per Arkansas Code 14-14-1202 (2)(A)(i) the county is applying for a Grant from the Arkansas Rural Community Grant Program, the purpose of the grant is to install a dump station at the County owned Cox Creek Lake Park.

WHEREAS, in applying for the Grant, Grant County is required to provide in-kind donations or local match of \$15,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Grant County Resolution 2021-01 resolved to match the project in the amount of \$15,000.00 through fees and in-kind donations.

WHEREAS, Unusual Circumstances come from being awarded the Arkansas Rural Community Grant to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, Grant County will provide in-kind donations of labor and equipment under the direction of State Licensed Quorum Court member Honorable Mark Allen, saving the county labor and equipment costs by hiring an outside vendor to complete the project.

WHEREAS, Grant County Quorum Court member Honorable Mark Allen will receive compensation for his oversight of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Quorum Court of Grant County, Arkansas, that the above stated unusual circumstances deems the use of services offered by Honorable Mark Allen permittable under Arkansas Code 14-14-1202 (2)(A)(i); and

WHEREAS, Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after it passage and approval.
