Be It Enacted By the Quorum Court of Grant County, State of Arkansas, an Ordinance to be Entitled:

An Ordinance to Repeal Ordinance No. 2015-02

WHEREAS, the 93rd General Assembly of the State of Arkansas, during its regular session, passed Act 435, which amended Arkansas Code Annotated Section 14-22-102;

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated Section 14-22-102 governs the procedures for competitive bidding and purchasing procedures for counties and municipalities;

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated Section 14-22-102 has raised the purchase limit, before competitive bidding is required, to \$35,000.00, and allows the increase of this purchase limit, as gaged by the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers, or its successor, in five-year intervals;

WHEREAS, the amendment of Arkansas Code Annotated Section 14-22-102 has made Grant County Ordinance No. 2015-02 unnecessary.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GRANT COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Grant County Ordinance No. 2015-02 is not necessary, pursuant to the amendments made by the 93rd General Assembly, to Arkansas Code Annotated Section 14-22-102, therefore Grant County Ordinance No. 2015-02 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. The Quorum Court of Grant County hereby finds and determines an immediate clarification of the requirements and procedures of the competitive bidding procedure is necessary to protect the financial integrity of the County Government, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety shall be in effect from and after its passage and approval.
