APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2021-16

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF ARKANSAS:

AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2020-11, THE 2021 ANNUAL BUDGET, GRANT COUNTY ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Grant County Library has a building improvement project that includes painting the exterior of the building; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has agreed to assist with this project by transferring \$10,000 to the Grant County Library Fund from the Grant County General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act signed by the President on March 11, 2021, allowed for certain salaries and related expenses to be reimbursed to the County out of the funding received from the Act and this reimbursement can be set aside as unrestricted funds; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined the 911 dispatcher salaries and related expenses for payroll dated 3/10/21 through 12/16/21 qualifies for said reimbursement from the American Rescue Plan Fund; and

WHEREAS, the County General Fund and the American Rescue Plan Fund have money available for the above described transfers.

THEREFORE, this Court amends the 2021 budget for said purposes.

Section 1. Budget Amendment.

This amendment to the 2021 Annual Budget, Grant County Arkansas appropriates the following expenditures:

County General Fund 1000

Transfer to County Library Fund 1000-8888-9999 \$10,000.00 American Rescue Plan Fund 3046

Transfer to ARP Unrestricted Fund 3046-8888-9999 \$411,152.38

Section 2. Purpose. This Ordinance shall constitute new appropriations for the purposes specified for the calendar year 2021 subject only to revision or modification by the Quorum Court.

Section 3. Revenues. This Ordinance shall also reflect unanticipated revenues of \$10,000.00 for the County Library Fund as a transfer from County General Fund and \$411,152.38 for the ARP Unrestricted Fund as a transfer from American Rescue Plan Fund in the 2021 Annual Budget, Grant County Arkansas.

Section 4. <u>Severability.</u> If any provision of the Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provision or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 5. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall be in force and shall take effect upon passage and approval.
