**APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2023-11**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

**AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2022-14, THE 2023 ANNUAL BUDGET, GRANT COUNTY ARKANSAS.**

**WHEREAS**, it comes before this Court that there is a need to make additional appropriations to the 2023 Annual Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, this Court finds that the remodel of the County Annex is moving along at a more rapid pace than originally anticipated and to continue with the next phase of the project without interruption an additional appropriation needs to be made from the ARPA Revenue Replacement Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, this Court finds there is \$21,000.00 of unobligated funds remaining in the Emergency Medical 2017 Tax Fund Grants-In-Aid appropriation and desires to make grants available to the fire departments in the County; and

**WHEREAS**, this Court finds there is not enough appropriation remaining to allow for each fire department to have a \$4,000.00 grant opportunity.

**THEREFORE**, the Court hereby amends the 2023 Annual Budget to reflect the following expenditures:

**Section 1. Budget Amendment.**

This amendment to the 2023 Annual Budget, Grant County Arkansas appropriates the following expenditures:

ARPA Revenue Replacement Fund - County Annex		
Building Materials & Repairs	1006-0121-2020	\$ 600,000.00
Emergency Medical 2017 Tax Fund - Grants-In-Aid		
Grants-In-Aid	3407-0116-3103	\$ 19,000.00

**Section 2. Purpose.** This Ordinance shall constitute new appropriations for the purposes specified for the calendar year 2023 subject only to revision or modification by the Quorum Court.

**Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of the Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provision or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** Per Arkansas Code annotated §14-14-907 this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval.
