APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2023-13

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT, STATE OF ARKANSAS:

AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 2022-14, THE 2023 ANNUAL BUDGET, GRANT COUNTY ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, it comes before this Court that there is a need to make additional appropriations to the 2023 Annual Budget; and

WHEREAS, this Court finds that there is an upcoming need to replace the drug task force vehicle; and

WHEREAS, this Court finds there is a shortage of vehicles available to law enforcement and a suitable vehicle has been located and desires that an appropriation be made for its purchase; and

WHEREAS, this Court finds there is fund 1801 on the Treasurer's books so titled DTF Vehicle Fund that was established by this Court to help offset the purchase cost of replacement vehicles.

THEREFORE, the Court hereby amends the 2023 Annual Budget to reflect the following expenditures:

Section 1. Budget Amendment.

This amendment to the 2023 Annual Budget, Grant County Arkansas appropriates the following expenditure:

DTF Vehicle Fund
 Vehicle 1801-0400-4005 \$ 44,893.00
 Emergency Medical 2017 Tax Fund
 Transfer Out 3407-8888-9999 \$ 6,000.00

Section 2. Purpose. This Ordinance shall constitute new appropriations for the purposes specified for the calendar year 2023 subject only to revision or modification by the Quorum Court.

Section 3. Revenue. This Ordinance shall reflect unanticipated revenues in the 2023 Annual Budget, Grant County Arkansas for the following:

Transfer from the Emergency Medical 2017 Tax Fund to the DTF Vehicle Fund \$ 6,000.00

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of the Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provision or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 5. Effective Date. Per Arkansas Code annotated §14-14-907 this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval.
