Be it resolved by the Quorum Court of Grant County, Arkansas a resolution entitled:

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE TRANSPORTATION AND DISPOSAL AGREEMENT FOR WASTE DISPOSAL SERVICE BETWEEN WASTE MANAGEMENT OF ARKANSAS, INC. AND GRANT COUNTY, ARKANSAS, WHICH GRANTS WASTE MANAGEMENT PINE BLUFF HAULING COMPANY TO PROVIDE WASTE TRANSPORTATION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES TO GRANT COUNTY, ARKANSAS; AND

WHEREAS, the County currently has an transportation and disposal agreement between Waste Management of Arkansas, Inc. and Grant County for the Waste Management Pine Bluff Hauling Company to provide transportation and waste disposal services; and

WHEREAS, according to AR article 14-22-106 a renewal or an extension of the term of an existing contract is exempted from soliciting bids; and

WHEREAS, Grant County and Waste Management of Arkansas, Inc. wish to extend said agreement to continue such transportation and waste disposal services to Grant County; and

WHEREAS, Grant County and Waste Management of Arkansas, Inc. have entered into agreements for transportation and waste disposal service since 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court believes that it is beneficial to continue to have Waste Management of Arkansas, Inc. provide transportation and disposal services to Grant County, and

WHEREAS, Grant County and Waste Management of Arkansas, Inc. have agreed to a financial agreement for June 1, 2020 thru May 31, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GRANT COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The Quorum Court authorizes the County Judge to enter into a three (3) year extension of the agreement with Waste Management of Arkansas, Inc. granting Waste Management Pine Bluff Hauling Company to provide transportation and waste disposal services to Grant County, beginning June 1, 2020.

Section 2. Grant County will pay transportation and disposal fees to Waste Management of Arkansas, Inc. as follows beginning June 1, 2020 and continue until May 31, 2023:

Section 3. For purposes of this resolution, the term "transportation and disposal" shall include the transportation and disposal of all acceptable waste collected and/or transported by or for the County and its customers to the Transfer Station. Grant County Transfer Station agrees that it will accept such Acceptable Waste for transportation and disposal at the Disposal Facility. The County warrants that the waste delivered to the Transfer Station hereunder will not contain any Unacceptable Waste.

Section 4. Severability. In the event any portion of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of this resolution.

Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, which are in conflict with any provision of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
