A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANT COUNTY JUDGE AND GRANT COUNTY CIRCUIT CLERK TO APPLY FOR A GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE CIRCUIT CLERK'S OFFICE.

Whereas, Grant County is a Class Two county in the State of Arkansas and is therefore eligible to apply for a grant from the Arkansas Counties and administered by the Automated Records System Fund Committee:

Whereas, the Grant County Circuit Clerk's Office is currently scanning records into the CONTEXTE Court Management System, real estate records and all other recordings as required by law.

Whereas, The Grant County Circuit Clerk's Application is for eligible hardware, peripherals to include Internet and network installation to enable the Circuit Clerk's Office to continue to perform and comply with the requirements of the CONTEXTE Court Management System, Apprentice programs and all other programs utilized within the Clerk's office for recording.

Whereas, the Grant County Quorum Court recognizes the need for an additional work station and concurs with its importance, the need for reliable equipment and supports her efforts to continue to provide current records to the courts and the public.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Judge and the Circuit Clerk of Grant County are hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Association of Arkansas Counties Automated Records System for the purposes of securing funds to purchase hardware, software, Internet and Network capable of fulfilling the requirements of the Circuit Clerk's Office and that the Grant County Circuit Clerk is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project.
